Originally a granary, the 18th century Oak Barn has been transformed into a beautiful wedding venue and holiday accommodation in the Devon countryside. Situated between a grade I listed church and grade II medieval farmhouse it was essential the historic appearance of the barn was restored and the right atmosphere created.

The local conservation officer was involved in the project and approved the original Conservation Rooflight® due to its truly sympathetic appearance and the ability to flush fit the rooflights to blend seamlessly into the roof.



Six Conservation Rooflights® were specified for this project in a range of sizes.
